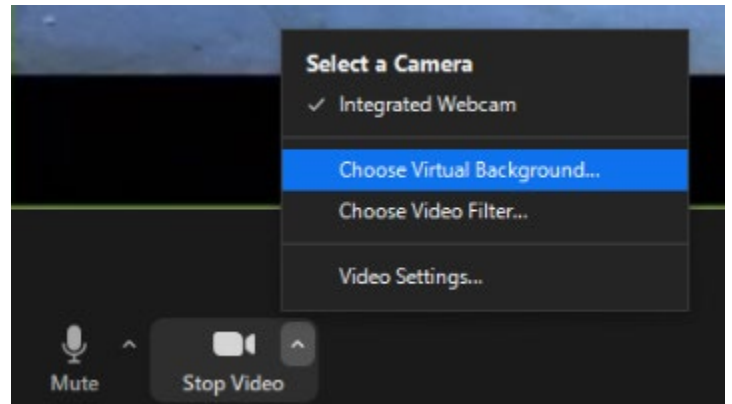


Add a Virtual Background & Filters:

- 1) Once in your party's Zoom link, look for the video icon in the bottom righthand corner of your Zoom window. Click the ^ and select "Choose Virtual Background"
